# **Supply List:**

Canvas:

Cotton, 16 x 20 or 18 x 24, acrylic primed, toned gray. (Linen is fine, too, but not necessary; oil-primed is also fine but not necessary.)

#### To tone your canvas:

If it is acrylic primed, tone with acrylic paint to a medium neutral gray (can use Golden brand N6 Neutral Gray, thinned with some water); if it is oil primed, tone with alkyd oil paint (fast drying) to a medium neutral gray.

#### For the first day you will need:

2 toned canvases

Brushes: Size 4 filberts (hog's bristle) qty: 2 (if buying from the school store, get the 'long' filberts) Size 2 filberts (bristle or synthetic) qty: 2

Artist-grade odorless mineral spirits (*must* be odorless, Gamsol preferred), and jar with lid.

Strong paper towels (viva brand or blue shop towels) or rags

Wood or glass palette

Palette knife (for cleaning palette)

Oil paints (professional grade): Burnt Sienna (or Transparent Red Oxide) (PR101) Ultramarine Blue Titanium white

#### Additional supplies you may need after the first day:

Alizarin Crimson (or a cool red such as permanent rose) Cadmium Red 1901 S. 9<sup>th</sup> Street | Bok Building, 7<sup>th</sup> Floor | Philadelphia, PA 19148 | 215.592.7910

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### Cadmium Yellow (Students are welcome to bring more colors if they have them)

You will need 7-8 canvases for the whole course.

Note: All supplies except the palette will also be available through the school store on the first day of class.
